## WHAT WE DO

Moreton Bay Boat Club has put together a course designed for adults in order to teach you both the theory and practical side of sailing.

This course involves Start Sailing 1 & 2 criteria set by Yachting Australia which contains in depth theory knowledge and also practical knowledge which will be practiced out on our waters in 3.7m Vagabond dinghy's containing 2 sails.

- Learn knots and other sailing based theory
- Knowledge of wind and its effect on sailing
- Learn how to apply theories behind sailing whilst out on the water
- Learn to rig and de-rig our dinghy's and the process of taking care of boats on water and land
- Build your confidence in both theory and practical situations

## SAGS and WAGS

Saturday Afternoon Good Sailing (SAGS) and Wednesday Afternoon Good Sailing (WAGS) events are social yacht races sailed as "pursuit" races with a handicap start. Each yacht is allocated a start time before the event, based on past performance.

The aim is to have all yachts finish close together then socialise as a group at the Moreton Bay Boat Club lounge afterwards, where results are announced and presentations made.
